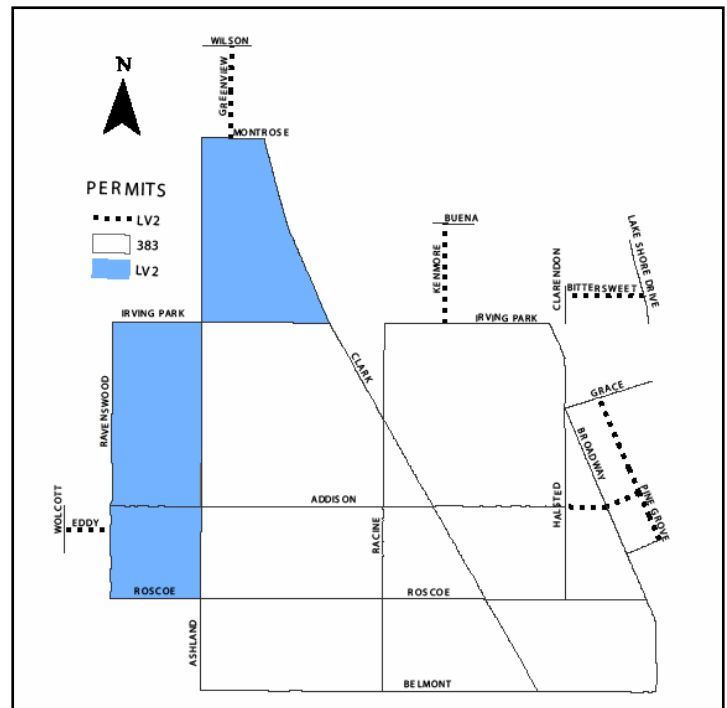


Lake View Community Night Baseball Resident Parking Advisory

Zone 383 residential permit parking is now in place on all Lake View residential streets in the area bounded by Irving Park Road, Broadway, Addison Street, and Ashland Avenue. These streets will continue to be a Cubs' night game tow zone from 5 PM to 10 PM on night game dates.

Residents in the 383 zone **MUST** purchase their 1st 383 RPP sticker in person - either at a City Clerk's Office or at their Alderman's office when the City Clerk comes to sell their stickers. In following years they will get a renewal notice, but the first sticker must be purchased in person. These residents will no longer be mailed a free LV2 resident parking permit.

The annual fee for a parking permit is \$25. Single day guest permits are available at a cost of \$8 for a book of 15 permits. Residents must have a current Chicago city vehicle sticker and show proof of residence and a receipt for the City Sticker to purchase the parking permit.



Most eligible residents that live in the remaining LV2 zone (streets north of Irving Park, west of Ashland, and east of Broadway) were mailed a permit and a guest passes. Additional permits and guest passes, including single game guest passes for businesses, are available at their respected Aldermanic offices.

Also, residents are reminded, per section 9-68-020 of the Chicago Municipal Code, all parking permits may not be transferred, purchased or sold. Violators are subject to a fine of up to \$500.

Residents are advised of the night baseball resident parking enforcement policy:

- **Night BB (LV2) Resident Parking Permits are not valid in the 383 Zone.** LV2 permits will only be valid on posted LV2 streets.
- **Zone 383 Resident Parking Permits are not valid in the LV2 Zone.** Zone 383 permits will only be valid on posted Zone 383 streets.

Vehicle towed as a result of any enforcement action are towed to Auto Pound #6 at 701 N. Sacramento (773) 265-7605. It will cost, at minimum, \$160.00 to retrieve a vehicle. A citizen can check to see if their car has been towed by calling 311.
