CUBS NIGHT GAME REMINDER

Cubs night games have begun!

Residents of the Lake View - Uptown Community are reminded that there is a **Cubs Night Game Permit Parking Program** in effect in the residential community around Wrigley Field during the 30 night games played by the Cubs. Each resident living within the program area having a current City Vehicle sticker is mailed a Night Baseball Parking Permit at the beginning of the season. Those residents living in a standard Zone 383 Resident Parking Zone within the Program area can use the 383 Permit instead of the night baseball parking permit during Cubs night games. **Parking on Program area streets without a Permit being displayed can result in your car being towed.**

Residents may request parking violation enforcement on their streets by reporting violations to the Chicago Police Hotline - 1 (866) 4CPD-TOW.
