## Vehicle Sticker & Residential Parking Permits (Zone 383)

The City Clerk's Office will be selling City of Chicago Vehicle Stickers (Passenger, Senior Citizens, Truck "A" and Motor Cycles) and Residential Parking Permits (Zone 383) at the Ward Service Office, 1057 W Belmont on Tuesday, June 20 and Wednesday, July 5 from 9AM to 6PM. In order to purchase your stickers, you must provide:

- Proof of Residence (drivers License, Utility Bill or Lease)
  - Photo ID
  - City Sticker Receipt (to purchase Residential Parking Permit)
  - Current Vehicle Registration (to purchase Vehicle Sticker)
  - One check for each sticker purchased, made payable to "City Clerk"
- Cash will be accepted. No Credit or Debit Cards.
- Please arrive no later than 5:30PM. Please have all applications and checks complete before you arrive.
