Here's a special offer for Lake View residents. Beginning tomorrow morning, Friday, March 16th at 9AM, you can enter to purchase up to 4 tickets to the upcoming "Police" concert at Wrigley Field. July 5th has been officially announced with another one tentatively planned for the following day per the agreement reached with the neighborhood. It's official! Wrigley Field will host the legendary group, The Police, on Thursday, July 5, 2007. LVCC has worked with the Chicago Cubs to reserve 3,000 tickets at all price points for purchase by neighborhood residents. Details on how to purchase these tickets are below.

In connection with the concert, the Cubs will play one less night game this year, donate \$150,000 to the community and offer a special allocation of 3,000 tickets for purchase by residents in neighboring zip codes (60613, 60614, 60640 and 60657). There will also be special neighborhood

#### Some restrictions include:

Registration for the drawing begins at 9:00 a.m. Central time on Friday, March 16, 2007, and closes at 5:00 p.m. Central time on Monday, March 19, 2007. A random drawing will be held on or about Tuesday, March 20, 2007, to select winners from the pool of registrants. Each winner will have the opportunity to purchase up to four tickets at face value, plus convenience and handling fees, and subject to availability to see The Police perform at Wrigley Field. Participation in the drawing or being notified of winning does not guarantee ticket availability. By the time you enter the system to purchase tickets you may not find four seats together or four seats on the date you choose. You may only purchase seats next to each other.

To be eligible for this opportunity, you must be 18 years of age or older. Eligibility is limited to persons with a valid current address in zip codes 60613, 60614, 60640 or 60657 and from whom Cubs have received a completed entry form located below during the registration period. Address on the credit card must match address submitted on application form. Entries submitted from commercial addresses may be voided.

**Limit one entry per person and per e-mail address.** Entrants must use their own name. Entries generated by a script, macro or other mechanical or automated means, and multiple entries for the same e-mail address, are prohibited and may be voided. Duplicate entries may void all entries from same address and/or person. Winning entries are not transferable. Cubs are not responsible for lost, incomplete, damaged, illegible, late or misdirected entries, errors in mechanical transmission, technical difficulties or inability to transmit entries, or any e-mail notifications bounced back or misdirected.

Individual tickets for the concert are \$254, \$94 or \$54, depending on seat location. There are also per ticket fees and service charges for each ticket ordered. All sales are final. In the event a winner does not respond to notification by purchasing tickets before 8:00 p.m. on Friday, March 23,

2007, the ability to purchase tickets via this drawing will be forfeited.
