As promised, a special allocation of tickets to Jimmy Buffett's performances in Wrigley Field will soon be available for purchase by neighborhood residents. These tickets have been set aside by the Chicago Cubs as part of their on-going community efforts.

Since there is a limited number of tickets available, a random drawing will be held for the opportunity to purchase these tickets. Residents who are interested in purchasing tickets must fill out and submit a registration form beginning at 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, June 21, 2005 at www.tickets.com/cubsneighbor.

Registration will close at 5:00 p.m. on Friday,

June 24, 2005. A random drawing will be held on or about June 25, 2005, to select winners who will have the opportunity to purchase up to four tickets for one of the performances at Wrigley Field. Individual tickets for the concert are either \$130 or \$90 and higher, depending on seat location, plus convenience and handling fees.

The first concert will be held at 6:00 PM on Sunday September 4. The second concert will be held at 2:00 PM on Monday, September 5. To be eligible, you must be 18 years of age or older, have a valid current address in zip codes 60613 and 60657 and submit a valid entry form during the registration period.
