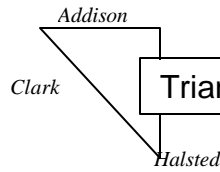

## Market Days This Weekend

The 24th Annual Northalsted Market Days are fast approaching this weekend. In case you're new to the area, the two-day event is the largest street fair in the Midwest. Over a hundred thousand will attend.

There are more than 40 entertainers on three stages that include Duncan Sheik (with hits like "Barely Breathing") and Judy Tenuta (stand-up comic and actress) - - plus food and craft vendors.

Logistically speaking, Halsted will be closed from Belmont to Addison from the very early morning on Saturday, August 6th to the early morning on Monday, August 8th. Note access to the feeder streets will be closed, too.

The suggested donation this year will be \$6 per person, one dollar higher than in the past. Proceeds benefit Northalsted Area Merchant Association (NAMA) and The Center on Halsted.

## Under the "E1" Parking: Newport to Addison

The CTA "Under 'E1' Parking Program" was created in the hope of increasing parking in neighborhoods while utilizing and improving CTA property located underneath CTA's elevated structures. The program creates legal parking underneath the elevated ("E1") structure and offers neighborhood residents and businesses the first opportunity to obtain a license to park in these locations.

- Cars currently parking "Under the 'E1'" will receive notices on their windshield shortly
- You must have a permit or you will be towed
- You must apply via Standard Parking in August
- Monthly parking rates run \$50-75 for residents and \$75-\$85 for businesses
