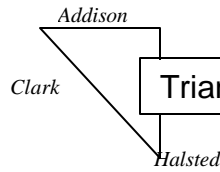

Triangle Annual Meeting June 8th: Learn how you can get more involved in your neighborhood

Ever wonder how you can help make more of a difference in your neighborhood? One answer is to renew your membership and volunteer with TNA, Triangle Neighbors Association, the group representing our local community in a variety of issues.

As our annual meeting on June 8th approaches, we look back how TNA and its residents rallied upon several initiatives to improve quality of life in Lake View over the last year.

The neighborhood lent vocal support to the building of a LeMoyne community campus and new 23rd District Police Station on Addison Street, the northern boundary of TNA. The residents petitioned Alderman Tunney to install speed-humps on the 800-900 blocks of West Roscoe Street (due late Summer 2005). Neighbors banded together to protect the historic nature of 800-900 W Newport and even got the street designated a "Historic Landmark Zone". And maybe most importantly, grass-roots efforts raised over \$650,000 to start acquiring two parcels to become a community garden at 815-817 W Roscoe Street.

Through the various fundraisers, including the annual Halloween Parade on Halsted Street and

Chicago Cubs game outings, Triangle Neighbors brought new and lifetime residents together to build a sense of community.

Triangle Neighbors will be holding its annual meeting this Wednesday, June 8, 2005 (7PM) at the LVCC Offices located at the lower level of 867 W Buckingham. All residents in Triangle Neighbors are strongly encouraged to attend.

This year's meeting has two primary purposes: to elect new officers and to ratify the updated by-laws for Triangle Neighbors. We'll also pass out the latest zoning map and provide updates on the LVCC Summer Fest, LVCC Garden Walk and Space: An Urban Eden.

Each year, Triangle elects a new President, Vice President, Treasurer, Secretary, and two delegates each to the LVCC Board of Directors and the 44th Ward Community Directed Development Council (CDDC).
