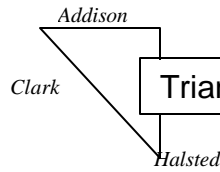

## Going Green in Lake View: Space Park and Lakeview Garden Walk

We are nearing our first milestone as we hope to close on the first of two lots on the 800 block of west Roscoe Street by the end of June 2005.

Triangle Neighbors is fortunate to be working with a concerned resident-owner who also wants to see both of the lots at 815 and 817 W Roscoe Street turned into a neighborhood park. The new park, entitled Space: An Urban Eden, will be deeded to NeighborSpace, a land-trust organization created by the City of Chicago, the Chicago Park District, and Cook County. The park will be managed by a committee in Triangle Neighbors.

Once built, the park will serve as a community meeting point, open during day light hours and locked at night. Donors who contribute \$500 or more can place a message on a brick at the

But before the park is even built, Triangle Neighbors is greening up the neighborhood in anticipation of the annual Lakeview Garden Walk, held this year on July 10th.

The Lakeview Garden walk has become a much anticipated event in our community. This year's walk takes place from noon to 5PM the same day as the Clark Street Festival, another LVCC-sponsored event. Like last year, maps, balloons on all the participating gardens, and a free trolley service will be provided to help you identify some hidden gems within our community.
