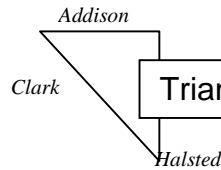

We have much to celebrate this holiday season. As many of you know, it's been a very busy year for Triangle Neighbors.

We've made a lot of progress and are optimistic we will be able to purchase the second (adjacent) lot for our new, community garden park at 815-817 W Roscoe Street. Stay tuned to next month's edition of the Tales for more details and don't forget to buy your brick!

We've worked with the City to have major capital improvements on Roscoe Street - having it re-surfaced, having speed bumps installed, and placing "no parking signs" around the 2 sewers that continually are clogged by debris (and then flood). We pledge to continue addressing the flooding issue from Buckingham to Cornelia and have invited Assistant Commissioner Tom LaPorte to speak at our next Triangle Neighbors' meeting on December 13th.

We've partnered with the 23rd Police District to "take back Halsted." The late night walks will start up again in the Spring. We support the local CPD steering committee and purchased for their use a new digital camera.
