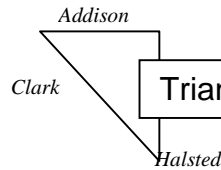

Gay Pride: Neighborhood Summer Events

June is Gay Pride month and there are a lot of things going on in the neighborhood celebrating the theme "Pride: Not Prejudice."

Fair Illinois, a group of concerned citizens, is looking for volunteers at their offices at 3342 N Halsted (9AM - 10PM) to validate if the signatures submitted to ban gay marriage and outlaw any type of domestic partnership can be placed on the Illinois ballot. The 37th Annual Gay Pride Parade is scheduled for Sunday, June 25th. Last year's event attracted 400,000-500,000 spectators with over 250 registered parade entries. The parade officially kicks off at 12N at Halsted and Belmont. Please note parking bans and street closures will be in effect on Halsted.

The closing ceremony of the Gay Games will be held on Saturday, July 22nd at Wrigley Field. We've been told it may sell out with as many as 40,000 spectators and participants heading towards our neighborhood in the late afternoon. Triangle Neighbors is working to coordinate the impact to our area and combine it with a Space Park fundraising event. More to follow.

Space Park: Final Six Month Extension

We've made a lot of progress since last June when we closed on the first lot (815 W Roscoe) of what we hope will become Space: An Urban Eden community garden and park. We've actually raised hundreds of thousands of dollars, including a recent \$50,000 donation (*thanks Paul Douglas*). The GimmeSpace Golf Tournament was sold out and a huge success.

The problem is we are still short of our goal. We were able to negotiate a six-month extension to

purchase the second (adjacent) lot to the end of this year. If we don't raise the money by the end of the year, we won't be able to purchase the lot.

What does this mean? **WE NEED YOUR HELP FINANCIALLY!** If you want to see the park in your neighborhood come to its full potential, we need you to write a check **TODAY**. Property Tax: File Appeal by June 29th

Property Tax Assessments for Lake View Township were mailed out on 5/25/06. Triangle Neighbors falls within neighborhood "84" which saw a 31.8% increase in median sales price in the last three years. This translates to an average increase in assessed value of \$19,946.

To learn more what this means to you, LVCC and the 44th Ward will be holding a Property Tax

Reassessment Outreach meeting on Tuesday, June 20th at 7PM at Illinois Masonic Olsen Auditorium (836 W Wellington).

We will walk you through how to file an appeal without hiring an attorney. If appealing, you need to act fast. The deadline to file an appeal is 6/29/06 with all supporting documentation due by 7/14/06.
